



Special Mobile Equipment & Special Equipment





- Is **driven**
- A motor vehicle with permanently mounted equipment not designed or used primarily for the transportation of persons or property.
- Includes, but is not limited to, road construction or maintenance machinery, or similar types of equipment.

Special Mobile Equipment

Class Code: TR



Definition

- Special Mobile Equipment is not designed to carry a **load**.
 - **Example: a *Grader* is designed to move material.**
- Commercial vehicles are designed to be able to take a load.
 - **Example: a *Dump Truck* which hauls gravel to a site.**

- ✓ Makes more frequent use of roadways
- ✓ Registered for actual weight of vehicle
- ✓ Well Drillers & Self-Propelled Air Compressors **must** be registered as Class A

- ✓ Makes less frequent use of roadways
- ✓ Registered for \$20/yr.
- ✓ Needs to obtain a permit if vehicle weighs more than 20,000 lbs.

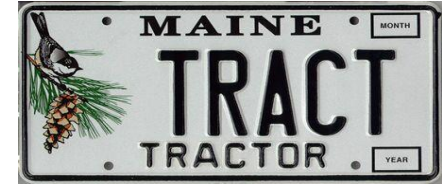

Registration Guidelines



Class Code: TR

Staggered registration

Title Exempt

Excise tax Due

- ✓ SNOWPLOW USE ONLY
- ✓ Valid from first snowfall until last snowfall of season.
- ✓ **MUST PASS FULL INSPECTION**

- Is **towed**.
- Not designed or used to convey property other than hand tools or parts used in connection with the operation of that equipment.
- Includes, but is not limited to, air compressors, conveyors, cement mixers, wood splitting or sawing machines, sprayers, compactors, pumps, drills and brush chippers.

Special Equipment

Class Code: SE



Definition

- Special Equipment is not designed to carry a **load**.
 - **Example: a *Splitter* is designed to split logs, not carry them down the road.**
- Trailers are designed to be able to take a load.
 - **Example: a *Boom Trailer* places objects on the trailer to be towed.**

- ✓ **Net Weight** determines fee
- ✓ Optional 2-year registration
- ✓ Proof of insurance not required



Special Equipment



- A **street sweeper** designed to pick up or sweep dirt and has a **water tank** is registered as **Class A**.
- A **street sweeper without a water tank** is designed to push dirt and registered as **Class B**.



- A **food concession trailer** is registered as **Special Equipment**

- ✓ Frequent Use of Highway
- ✓ Fee based on Registered Weight

CLASS A



- ✓ Infrequent Use of Highway
- ✓ \$20/yr.
- ✓ "Not Valid over 10 tons without Over Limit Permit from BMV"

CLASS B

Excise Due * Title Exempt *
Tires/Axles Required * *Consult Style Code List*

- ✓ Fee based on **Net Weight**
