SUBJECT: Vacation Accrual Rate - Former Public Service Employment Participants (CETA, Public Works)

RECISION: Personnel Bulletin 11.8, May 29, 1980.

A question has arisen concerning whether or not the vacation accrual rate for former Public Service employment participants is based on the date of Public Service employment, or on the date of State employment. This bulletin addresses that question.

If a transition has been made from Public Service employment to regular State employment without a break in service, the accrual rate shall be based on the date of Public Service employment.

If there has been a break in service between Public Service employment and regular State employment, the accrual rate shall be based on the date of regular State employment, and subsequent increases in the accrual rate shall be as provided by Chapter 11, Section 2B of the Personnel Rules.

This bulletin applies only to those regular State employees who were employed in Public Service (CETA or Public Works) positions sponsored by the State.
