INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Lorraine O'Donnell's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Maine, entered into pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(1-A)(B) and 10 M.R.S.A. Section 8003(5)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are: Lorraine O'Donnell, the Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 28, 1994 Ms. O'Donnell was convicted of the Class D criminal offense of stealing drugs, specifically 10 units of Pepcid from an individual patient at the Sandy River Nursing Care Center. Ms. O'Donnell was working at the time of the theft as Nursing Supervisor at the Sandy River Nursing Care Center.
2. As a result of this offense Ms. O'Donnell received a sentence that consisted of a \$200 fine, a restitution payment in the amount of \$40, and an agreement that she never again seek employment in the field of health care.

COVENANTS

Ms. O'Donnell agrees voluntarily to surrender her license to practice professional nursing in Maine. The Board will accept the voluntary surrender of Ms. O'Donnell's license with the following condition: should she petition the Board for reinstatement of her license, the decision on reinstatement at that point will be at the discretion of the Board. The Board agrees to take no further action upon these facts so long as Ms. O'Donnell fully complies with this Consent Agreement.

Ms. O'Donnell understands that this document is a Consent Agreement which extinguishes her legal right to practice nursing

in Maine. Ms. O'Donnell understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering this Consent Agreement. Ms. O'Donnell affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
