NOTICE OF DENIAL

Dear Mr. Paquette:

At its December 12, 2006 meeting, the Maine State Board of Nursing ("the Board") considered your application for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse in the State of Maine. The Board reviewed your application, (marked as Exhibit A), correspondence from the Board dated November 16, 2006, and correspondence from the California Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians dated November 27, 2006, with enclosures indicating the California Board's disciplinary actions (Exhibit B). The Board DENIED your application for licensure for the following reason(s):

- 1. In Section III. of the application, you were requested to disclose whether you ever held a license to practice nursing in any other state.
 - a. You failed to disclose that you were licensed as a nurse in the State of California from June 26, 1990 to July 31, 2004. Exhibit A and B.
- 2. In Section V. of the application, you were requested to disclose whether any board of nursing ever fined, warned, censured, or reprimanded you; and, whether you have had a nursing license placed on probation, denied, suspended or revoked in any state.
 - a. You answered "No" to both questions. You failed to disclose your nursing license in the state of California was revoked, effective October 13, 2004 and, that you were assessed an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00. Exhibit A and B.



Pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A (2) (A). The Maine Board may refuse to issue a nursing license to an individual who has engaged in "the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license. . . ."

You may appeal this decision and request a formal hearing before the Board by filing a written request within 30 days of receipt of this denial
