

## NCLEX-RN “FIRST TIME” TEST TAKERS PASS RATE

Practical Nurses: For the year October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015, 107 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for practical nurses and 39 passed; a 36.44% pass rate.

The national pass rate for the same time period was 80.17%.

(The total number of U.S. educated PN candidates was 12,952 with 80.71% passing the first time).

Registered Nurses: For the year October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015, 700 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for registered nurses and 604 passed; an 86.28% pass rate.

The national pass rate for the same time period was 81.87%.

(The total number of U.S. educated RN candidates was 157,803 with 81.87% passing the first time).
