

This map has approximate locations of the most intense 2020 activity by browntail moth caterpillars in Maine. Data are mapped from a small plane. Low populations are not mapped and some areas of moderate to high populations can be missed. There are other areas where people are likely to feel the effects of browntail moth hairs in 2021. Human impacts have been reported in areas with more than 10 overwintering webs per tree, these locations can be easily missed by all surveys. People are encouraged to look at their trees for signs of the overwintering webs (photo, right) of this insect and consider reducing populations where it is feasible.
