Job Descriptions & Qualifications:

Park Ranger

Starting at \$15.90/hour

Performs park maintenance and operations, offers exemplary customer service to park visitors and enforces rules and regulations. Other duties may be assigned.

Additional Qualifications: One year of experience in park maintenance and operations or equivalent. Valid Class C Maine motor vehicle operator's license.

Assistant Park Ranger

Starting at \$15.00/hour

Performs grounds maintenance, cleans restroom facilities, and assists with routine maintenance and repair of park facilities. In addition, Assistant Park Rangers assist with visitor services and enforcement of rules and regulations. Other duties may be assigned.

Additional Qualifications:

Knowledge and/or experience in park maintenance and operations or equivalent. Valid Class C Maine motor vehicle operator's license.

Customer Representative Assistant

Starting at \$15.00/hour

Greets visitors, provides information, collects fees, and registers day-use and campground visitors. Other duties may be assigned.

Additional Qualifications: Training, education, or experience in customer service. May require a valid Class C Maine motor vehicle operator's license.

Laborer

Starting at \$15.00/hour

Performs grounds maintenance, cleans restroom facilities, and assists with the routine maintenance and repair of park facilities (litter control, garbage collection, painting, etc.). Other duties may be assigned.

Additional Qualifications: Must be able to follow verbal and written instructions. Valid Class C Maine motor vehicle operator's license.



Lifeguard

Pay Rate = \$15.00 to \$17.72/hour*

Observes and protects swimmers at state park beaches; recognizes potential dangers and hazards. Assists visitors, enforces rules, and provides rescue services when necessary. Other duties may be assigned.

Additional Qualifications: Current lifeguard certification is required. Hiring is contingent upon successful completion of the Maine State Parks Lifeguard Academy; applicants must be able to run a 1.5-mile course in 12 minutes or less, complete a 500-yard paddleboard in 8 minutes or less, and swim 500M (open water) in 10 minutes or less.

Lifeguard Supervisor

Pay Rate = \$15.00 to \$18.59/hour*

Must meet all lifeguard requirements. Directs the activities of other lifeguards, ensures reports are completed correctly, oversees proper care & maintenance of equipment, and helps coordinate the work schedule. Other duties may be assigned.

Minimum Qualifications for all positions:

- At least 18 years old (16 years old for lifequards).
- Be a U.S. Citizen or a legal alien with permission to work in the U.S. and have proof of citizenship or a work permit.
- Able to work 40 hours a week, with weekend & holiday work required.
