## BASIS STATEMENT FOR ADOPTION OF CMR 01-026, CHAPTER 50—REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATORS AND DEALERS

## **Basis Statement**

Two amendments to Chapter 50 was proposed by the Board.

- As required as part of the state cooperative agreement with EPA, add requirements to dealer records of sales:
  - customer address
  - issuing authority, certification expiration date, and categories of certification in addition to the applicator's certification number
- Remove requirement for spray period records for major forest insect aerial spray programs. Since the requirements for monitors has been removed, it makes sense to remove the requirements for monitors to submit reports.

No comments were received.
