Inserts

An insert can be advertising material, a return envelope, a matched document, or any additional

printed paper that is combined with the document collation and is inserted into an envelope for mailing.

There is a way for a BOC application to be run EOC. If you feed the collation pages from "high

to low", that is, if you feed the last page first and page 1 last, then it acts the same as an EOC

application. To be able to make this work, however, you must be able to fold the collation in such

a way that the address displays in the correct orientation. Whether or not the application can be

run high to low depends on the location of the address, as well as whether the type of folder that

was purchased can produce the type of fold needed.
