Air Emission License
Transfer**

FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application, pursuant to Title 38, Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 590 and 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (C.M.R.) ch. 115, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) finds the following facts:

I. Registration

Pike Industries, Inc. has requested the transfer of Air Emission License A-731-71-J-R/M from Bruce A. Manzer, Inc. to Pike Industries, Inc. through a letter to the Department dated February 13, 2018. Air Emission License A-731-71-J-R/M was issued to Bruce A. Manzer, Inc. on December 18, 2014. The facility is a hot mix asphalt plant and crushed stone and gravel facility.

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

II. Transfer Requirements

A. Title, Right, or Interest

In their application, Pike Industries, Inc. submitted copies of property deeds transferring ownership of the facility to Pike Industries, Inc. The parties have provided sufficient evidence of title, right, or interest in the facility to allow the transfer of the facility's licenses.

B. Technical Capacity and Intent

Pike Industries, Inc.'s acquisition of the facility is not expected to result in any significant change in the employees that currently operate the equipment, facilities, and conduct other activities. The facility's regulatory history with the Department demonstrates that the environmental personnel are competent in air pollution control. The information submitted in the application provides sufficient evidence that Pike Industries, Inc. has the technical capacity and intent to comply with their air emission license.

D. Certification

Pike Industries, Inc. certifies that there will be no increase in air emissions beyond that provided for in the existing licenses, either in quantity or type.
