Air Emission License
Minor Revision**

FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

A. Introduction

Wingfoot Commercial Tire Systems, LLC (Wingfoot) was issued Air Emission License A-1037-71-C-R on September 14, 2015, for the operation of emission sources associated with their tire retreading facility.

The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company (Goodyear), the owner and parent company of Wingfoot, has requested a minor revision to Wingfoot's air emission license (A-1037) that would reflect their facility's legal name change from Wingfoot to Goodyear.

The equipment addressed in this license amendment is located at 39 Thomas Drive, Westbrook, Maine.

B. Emission Equipment

There are no changes being made to the emission equipment that is included in this license.

C. Application Classification

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

This amendment will not increase emissions of any pollutant. Therefore, this amendment is determined to be a minor revision and has been processed as such.

D. Description of Minor Revision

Wingfoot was a registered legal entity doing business in the State of Maine until January 9, 2017 when Goodyear, its owner and parent company, filed to have Wingfoot's charter terminated with the State. Goodyear is a registered legal entity in the State of Maine and is presently in good standing. Goodyear has requested that the legal name on air emission license (A-1037) for this facility be changed from Wingfoot to Goodyear. No change of ownership or transfer of rights has been conveyed with this action as Goodyear presently owns Wingfoot. This minor revision is being processed solely to change the legal name on the air emission license from Wingfoot to Goodyear.

ORDER

The Department hereby grants Air Emission License Minor Revision A-1037-71-D-M, subject to the conditions found in Air Emission License A-1037-71-C-R and the following conditions.

Severability: The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Minor Revision or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Minor Revision shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
