FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the air emissions license amendment application, staff investigation reports and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes Annotated (M.R.S.A.), Section 344 and Section 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

A. Introduction

B. Revision Description

Fraser Timber LLC (Fraser) wishes to add cardboard as a permissible fuel for Boilers #1 and #3. The cardboard burned will be limited to that generated on-site from the purchase of goods and supplies.

C. Emission Equipment

D. Application Classification

The application submitted by Fraser does not violate any applicable federal or state requirements, does not reduce monitoring, reporting, testing or record keeping, and does not seek to modify a Best Available Control Technology (BACT) analysis.

The proposed revision will not change the facility's emission limits. Therefore, the amendment is determined to be a minor revision under *Minor and Major Source Air Emission License Regulations* 06-096 Code of Maine Rules (CMR) 115 (as amended). The procedures found in 06-096 CMR 115 (as amended) can be utilized to process this application since the proposed revision is not prohibited by the Part 70 air emission license. An application to incorporate the requirements of this amendment into the Part 70 air emission license has been received by the Department.

ORDER

The Department hereby grants Air Emission License Minor Revision A-165-77-2-M pursuant to the preconstruction licensing requirements of 06-096 CMR 115 and subject to the standard and special conditions below.

Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision, or part thereof, of this License shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.

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SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

(1) **Boilers #1 and #3**

A. Allowable Fuels

Boilers #1 and #3 are licensed to fire wood waste, petroleum soaked waste (oily rags, shop wipes, absorbent pads, oil/kerosene soaked sawdust, etc.) generated on-site, and cardboard generated on-site from the receipt of goods and supplies. [06-096 CMR 115, BACT]
