Dear Kathy:

I am writing regarding the status of Mallinckrodt's September 13, 2018, petition for modification of the Board of Environmental Protection's April 14, 2014, order governing remediation of the former HoltraChem site in Orrington. As you are aware, Mallinckrodt's and DEP's project teams met on November 20th to discuss the petition and the concerns of DEP staff regarding the relief requested. At that meeting, Mallinckrodt's representatives clarified that the pending petition does not, in all respects, reflect Mallinckrodt's current position on how the Board's order should be modified. For example, we now understand that Mallinckrodt does not intend to pursue modifications to the order that: (1) would allow unsaturated soils (fill or native) with contamination above the Media Protection Standard (MPS) to remain in place, or (2) leave soils above the MPS underneath the former Cell, Retort, and Old Retort Buildings.

Please submit a revised petition that fully reflects Mallinckrodt's current position on the modifications that Mallinckrodt seeks to the order. The revised petition should address the two issues identified above, as well as any other amendments to the current petition - whether discussed at our recent meeting or not - that Mallinckrodt may wish to make. We ask that the revised petition be as clear and specific as possible as to the requested modifications.

After consulting with the Maine Office of Attorneys General, the Department will provide the revised petition to the Interveners in the court proceedings (The Maine Peoples Alliance and the Town of Orrington), for a 30 day comment period prior to the Department making a recommendation on the revised petition.
