


Maine had 107 cases of infectious syphilis in 2019

Case Characteristics:

Syphilis 2019: Both infectious and non-infectious


Demographics:

Prevention

- Correct and consistent use of latex condoms (prevents contact with sore).
- Being in a long-term mutually monogamous relationship with a partner who has been tested and is known to be uninfected.
- Sexual partners of infected patients should receive preventive treatment.

Treatment

Stage	Treatment
Primary, Secondary, Early Non- Primary/Non-Secondary	Recommended Regimen Benzathine Penicillin G (Bicillin L-A) 2.4 million units IM once
	Alternative Regimen (For penicillin-allergic, non-pregnant only) Doxycycline 100mg orally 2 times a day for 14 days or Tetracycline 500mg orally 4 times a day for 14 days
