State and Local Agency Unallowable Costs

Authority

2 CFR §200

Policy

1. The Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention – WIC Nutrition Program will not reimburse Local Agencies for unallowable costs.

Procedure

1. Unallowable costs include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - 1.1 Alcoholic beverages
 - 1.2 Bad debts
 - 1.3 Contingencies
 - 1.4 Contributions and donations
 - 1.5 Entertainment, including food and beverages
 - 1.6 Fines and penalties
 - 1.7 Fundraising and investment management costs
 - 1.8 Operating costs for the Legislature or Governor's office.
 - 1.9 Idle facilities
 - 1.10 Interest and other financial costs
 - 1.11 Lobbying
 - 1.12 Membership in any organization engaged in lobbying
 - 1.13 Prosecution and defense of criminal and civil proceedings and claims
 - 1.14 Under-recovery of costs under federal agreements
 - 1.15 Parking at normal place of business
