

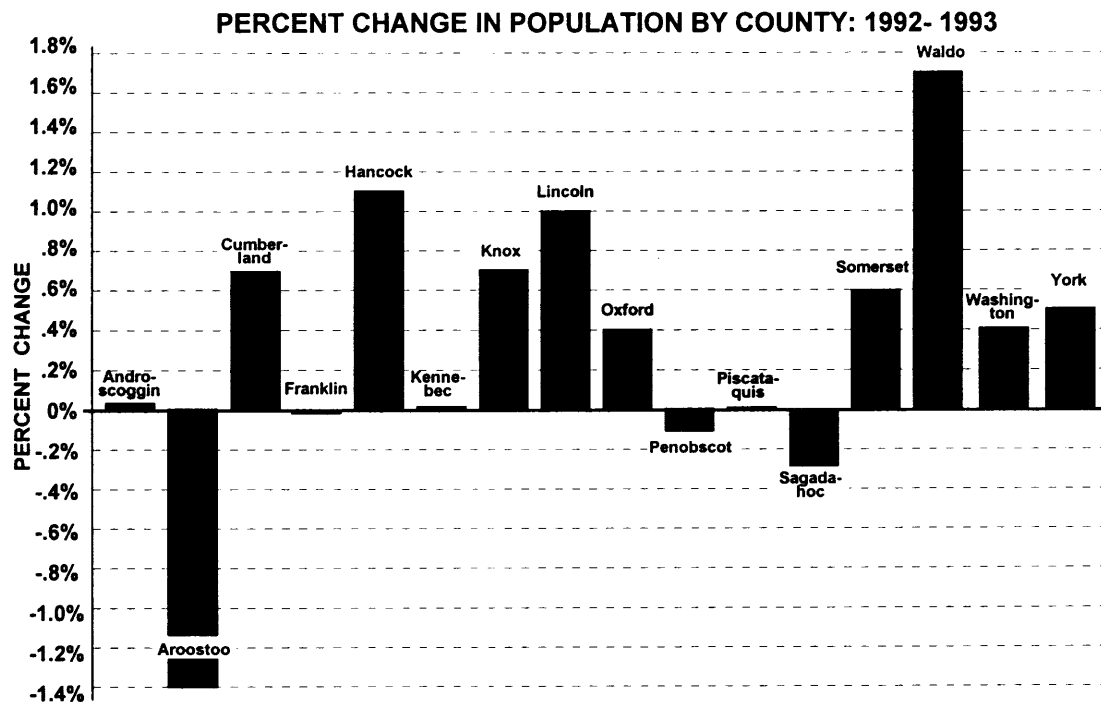
POPULATION ESTIMATES FOR MAINE

July 1, 1993

- ➔ Maine's estimated population for July 1, 1993 is 1,239,779; this is a statewide increase of 3,431 over the 1992 statewide estimates.

- ➔ Ten of Maine's 16 counties experienced population increases between 1992 and 1993; however, Aroostook, Sagadahoc and Penobscot counties all experienced decreases. The populations of Kennebec, Franklin, and Piscataquis counties remained relatively constant.
- ➔ Aroostook county, Maine's 6th most populated county, experienced the greatest net population loss between 1992 and 1993 (1,222 residents); it also had the greatest proportional drop in population (1.4%).
- ➔ Waldo county experienced the greatest percent population increase between 1992 and 1993. The county gained more than 550 residents, a population increase of 1.7%.
