

# POPULATION ESTIMATES FOR MAINE

July 1, 1995

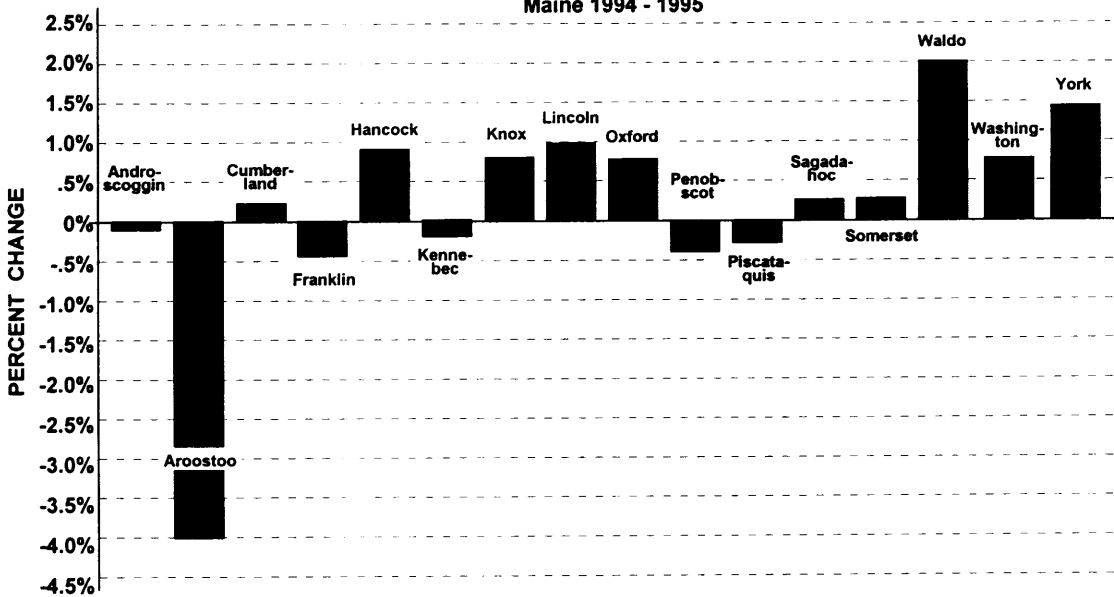
➔ Maine's estimated population for July 1, 1995 is 1,241,382; this is a statewide increase of 1,102 over the 1994 statewide estimates.

➔ Six of Maine's sixteen counties experienced population losses between 1994 and 1995 - Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Kennebec, Penobscot, and Piscataquis counties.

➔ The drop in population in Aroostook county represented the most dramatic change in population in any county. The loss of more than 3,000 residents there accounted for a 4% change in the county's total population. An increase of 2,411 residents in York county, the largest numeric increase statewide, accounted for a change of less than 1.5%.

➔ Although the state population, as a whole, has increased by slightly more than 1% since the 1990 census, the population of Aroostook county has decreased by almost 10% during that time.
