We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocations for 2024, and hereby approve them as follows:

Commercial	Senior Nonresident	10%	\$0
Commercial	Junior/Student Resident	No Limit Set	\$10
Commercial	Junior/Student Nonresident	10%	\$10
Recreational	Resident	No Limit Set	\$25
Recreational	Nonresident	10%	\$50
Recreational	Senior Resident	No Limit Set	\$0
Recreational	Senior Nonresident	10%	\$0
Recreational	Junior/Student Resident	No Limit Set	\$10
Recreational	Junior/Student Nonresident	10%	\$10

The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.

Licenses may be issued starting on May 28, 2024, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.
