Dear License Holder,

A recent amendment to DMR's Chapter 8 (Landings Program) regulations modified the reporting requirements of the scallop fishery to require those harvesters holding a commercial or non-commercial scallop license to submit **weekly trip-level catch reports during the scallop season using an approved electronic reporting method**. Reports are due by 11:59PM on Sunday each week.

Electronic reporting can be completed through either the [VESL](#) reporting application available for iOS and Android devices or [Maine LEEDS](#). If you hold a federal scallop permit and are required to submit vessel trip reports, you can use the [VESL](#) reporting application or can continue to report using Fish Online or eTrips to fulfill your state and federal reporting obligations.
