We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocation for 2023, and hereby approve them as follows:

The required $10 \%$ rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than $10 \%$ if desired.

| Recreational | 3 Day | 20 Per Month | $\$ 40.00$ |

Licenses may be issued starting on May 1, 2023, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.
