# **UNFINISHED OLD BUSINESS:**

REGULATION CHAPTER 115, "CREDENTIALING OF EDUCATION PERSONNEL"

<u>UPDATE</u>: The Deputy Commissioner, Department staff and the Certification and Higher Education Committee have been reviewing the 43 sets of comments

received on the proposed Chapter 115 and determined that three substantive changes need to be made to the rule. Substantive changes require that the State Board provides 30 days of public comment. The topics included in changes are as follows:

- Refined some of the grade spans
- Reinstated the Adaptive Physical Education (APE) endorsement
- Revised language per P.L.2021, Chapter 348, which requires that rules which used the term 'hearing impaired' be changed to 'hard of hearing'

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the State Board of Education vote to authorize the filing of the substantive changes articulated above in Chapter 115 rules and the Administrative Procedures Act forms with the Secretary of State's Office immediately following the October 26, 2021 Special State Board meeting.

MOTION by Wendy Ault, seconded by Victoria Kornfield, and unanimously voted by those present to amend Chapter 115 Part I Section 6.7 by moving B.1 into the introductory *B. Eligibility* statement; Part II Section 1 by eliminating "adolescent psychology" from 1.1.B.2.j; and to authorize the filing of the substantive changes as articulated above in Chapter 115 rules and the Administrative Procedures Act forms with the Secretary of State's Office immediately following the October 26, 2021 Special State Board meeting.
