- Copy of local or municipal permit <u>if required</u> by local ordinance.
- □ A copy of the certificate of public and product liability insurance with the minimum coverage limits of \$2,000,000.00 which lists the Maine Department of Public Safety, Fire Marshal's Office, 52 State House Station, Augusta, ME 04333-0052 as certificate holder.
- A copy of the permit to construct a consumer fireworks retail sales and storage facility where required by local or municipal ordinance.
- Floor plan and layout of the storage and displays to indicate compliance with this rule and applicable state or local laws, ordinances or regulations.

- Application for licensure is made pursuant to 8 M.R.S.A. §§ 221-A 236 (as amended by Public Law 2011, Chapter 416) and any rules adopted by the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety. The applicant has received a copy of Public Law Chapter 416 with this application packet.
- 2. The facility is in compliance with Maine's Uniform Building Code if applicable, and any other local or state laws. Proof of compliance, including proof such as a copy of the building permit if it was required or a letter from the local inspection official.
- 3. The facility shall remain in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinance, and regulations at all time while the license is in effect. - 5. The Fire Marshal's Office may, as part of its consideration of this application, or in its role as licensor, request such additional information, access and records as are reasonably necessary to determining whether the Applicant or licensee is in compliance with the statute and the conditions of licensure. The Applicant or licensee will cooperate with the Fire Marshal in this regard.
