MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

The motion passed 3 in favor, 1 abstention, motion passes.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

In October 2021 there were 9 shipments of machines and/or associated equipment shipped to or from licensed facilities. On-site inspectors completed 751 observations and 36 checklists. There were 10 self-exclusions. There were 3 minor potential violations that will continue to be monitored from our activity log. There were 0 patron complaints and 2 formal complaints of potential violations placed on the dashboard.

For the month of October 2021, the Unit has identified an increase of 58% in total tax revenue for both facilities versus October 2020. Year to date the Unit has identified an increase of 107% versus last year at the same time. Oxford reported an 8.0% win for the month of October from slots and 23.6% win from table games. Oxford's payback percentage was 91.9%. Average gross win per machine of \$258.02. Hollywood reported an 9.6% average win for the month of October from slots and 29.4% win from table games. Hollywood's payback percentage was 90.4%. Average gross win per machine was \$225.01.

The Unit has two bills in the upcoming short session beginning in January 2022 and ending in April. LD 2200 is An Act to Amend Certain Definitions in the Statutes Governing the Gambling Control Board, removing electronic facsimile from the definition in 8 M.R.S. § 1001(13-A) and (43-A) and adding electronic table game. LD 2197 is an Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Gambling Control Board, offering at the time of renewal a one-year or three-year license saving \$25 for the third year or the third year is free. One year is \$25, three years is \$50.

The Unit is waiting on the approved appropriations to initiate an online application for individuals of casino operators, distributors and service vendors. This will enable an individual to complete the process and potentially get a temporary license the same day.
