2. Request by State Rep. Jonathan Connor to Participate in Maine Clean Election Act Program for State Senate

State Rep. Jonathan Connor is seeking the Commission's approval to participate in the Maine Clean Election Act program to run for the State Senate. In 2021, he began to collect campaign contributions for re-election to the House and one of the contributions does not comply with the restrictions on seed money in the Maine Clean Election Act program.

3. Staff Update on Investigation of ALEC CARE Software

In July 2021, the Center for Media and Democracy filed a complaint alleging that the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC) has provided campaign software to legislative candidates in Maine who are members of ALEC and that the software amounts to an illegal campaign contribution. ALEC responded that the software is for the purpose of helping legislators manage their relationships with their constituents. The Commission staff will update the Commission on developments since the September 29, 2021 meeting.
