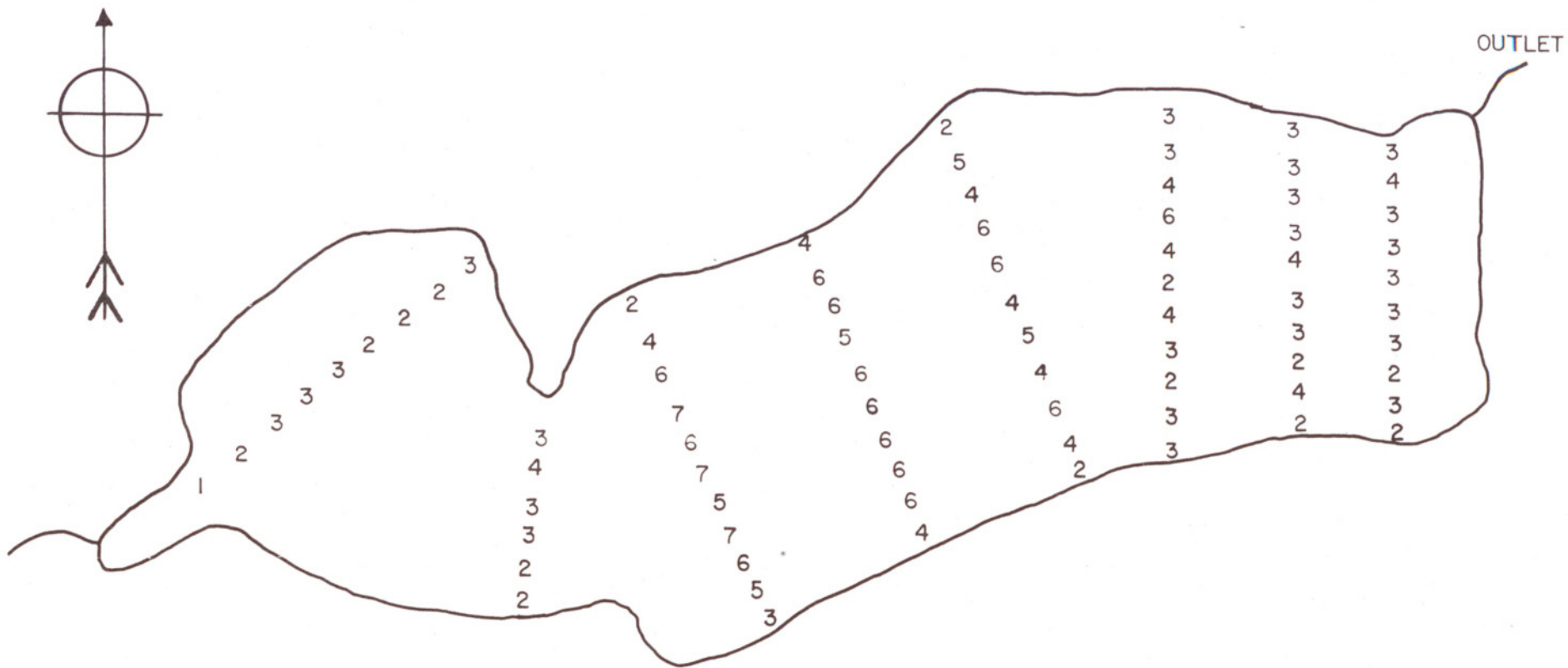
Suggested Management

Pickett Mountain Pond is shallow with similar water temperatures at all depths during the summer months. Trout seek limited areas of spring water influence when pond temperatures become warm.

Trout production is limited by competition with suckers, minnows, and sunfish for the available food supply, marginal water quality, and limited areas for natural reproduction.

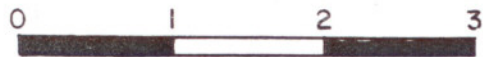
