### Physical Characteristics

Area - 37 acres

#### Temperatures

Surface - 72°F

Maximum depth - 4 feet

Withee Pond is located north of Johnson Mountain. A small inlet enters the east end of the pond and its outlet, Gulf Stream, flows west into Austin Stream. Bog vegetation completely surrounds the shallow pond. Its shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality for coldwater gamefish is poor in Withee Pond. No fish species were taken in the initial survey. Both the inlet and outlet have a thick silt layer for substrate, which would not allow for salmonids to reproduce naturally.

Withee Pond is accessible via a short walk through the woods from a logging road off Route 16. The pond is open to fishing under general law in the summer and closed to ice fishing.

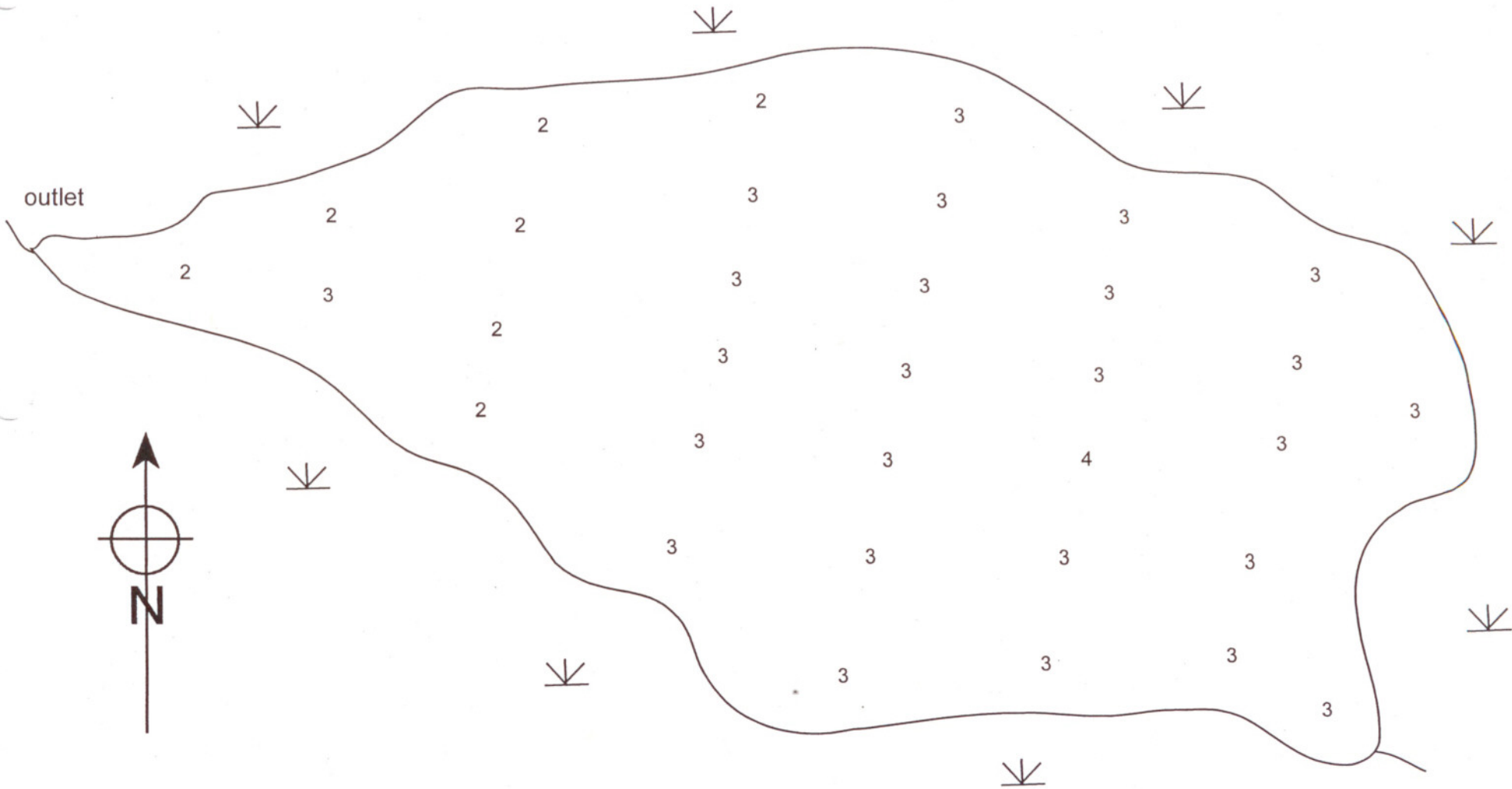
