Suggested Management

Norton Pond is best suited to warm-water game fishes. The fairly large amount of cold water present in late summer is too low in dissolved oxygen to support salmon or trout in any numbers.

Management should be for the existing warm-water game fishes. No salmon or trout should be stocked.
