**Testimony Position in Support of
LD 2099, “An Act to Make Changes to Certain Laws Governing Renewable Energy
Projects”**

Senator Lawrence, Representative Zeigler and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy, Utilities, and Technology,

My name is William Harwood, here today as Public Advocate, to testify in support of LD 2099, “An Act to Make Changes to Certain Laws Governing Renewable Energy Projects.”

Based on the representations in the testimony from the Governor’s Energy Office, the OPA supports LD 2099. Specifically, we support efforts to develop more renewable energy based on competitive bidding by developers, rather than a formula approach to compensate developers, such as our NEB program. We also appreciate the GEO’s efforts to develop a renewable energy program where the benefits are targeted to low income ratepayers who are struggling under our sky high electricity costs and have had little opportunity to participate in the NEB program.
