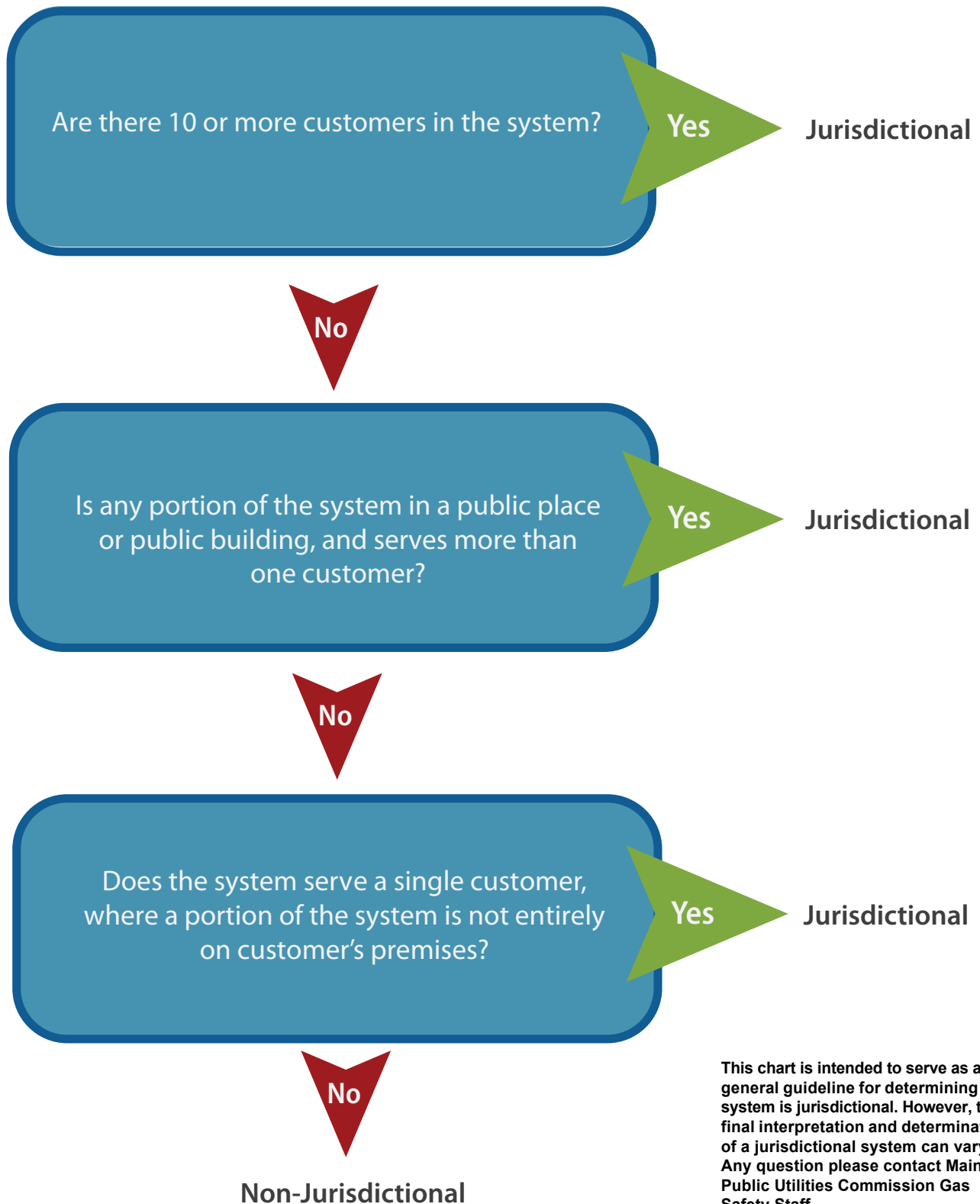


# Is It a Jurisdictional System?



This chart is intended to serve as a general guideline for determining if a system is jurisdictional. However, the final interpretation and determination of a jurisdictional system can vary. Any question please contact Maine Public Utilities Commission Gas Safety Staff.

## Definitions

**Facility:** The LPG distribution system that includes associated tanks and piping.

**Public building:** A building that is open to the public and caters to the public for services. Examples include; stores, bait shops, repair shops, restaurants, bars, etc.

**Public Place (ROW and land):** Roads, streets, boulevards, lakes, rivers, parks, national forests, and other government owned lands, etc.

**Customer:** Is a unit, a building owner, renter, leaser, employee's residence, renter of a motel/hotel, condo, and/or bed and breakfast with less than 30 day continuous stay with direct access to gas appliances, units do not need to be metered separately or metered at all.
