- 2. Start wrapping the pipe cleaner around the stick about 2" from one end. Once you've wrapped the first pipe cleaner, wrap one more.
- 3. Cut one pipe cleaner in half. Wrap one around the stick and form to make legs. Repeat for another set of legs.




