Dear Dr. Fox:

The Board of Osteopathic Licensure has received the enclosed Certification to Revoke License(s) & Recreational Vehicle Registration(s) against your license identified above, from the Maine Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Support Enforcement and Recovery. You have been identified and verified by the Department of Health and Human Services as an obligor who is not in compliance with a legal Child Support order.

The Board is required by law to take action against your license. This letter constitutes formal notice to you that your Maine license to practice osteopathic medicine is immediately revoked pursuant to the provisions of 19-A M.R.S. § 2201(6) (13) and 19 M.R.S. § 2202 (7).

<u>This revocation is final and cannot be appealed to the Board.</u> The practice of your profession after revocation constitutes unlicensed practice, a Class E crime.

The Board will consider reissuance of your license following receipt of a Statement of Compliance issued by the Department of Health and Human Services verifying that you are in compliance with your order of support [19-A M.R.S. § 2201(13) and (14)].
