

Kyra Klug v. MMG Insurance Company

The named insured requested a hearing to contest the cancellation of her automobile policy. The company cited the suspension of the insured's driver's as the reason for cancellation.

Held: For the company. Under section 2914(4) of the Maine Automobile Insurance Cancellation Control Act, 24-A M.R.S. §2914(4), a policy of automobile insurance may be canceled if the driver's license of a named insured or any operator who either resides in the same household or customarily operates an automobile insured under the policy is suspended or revoked during the policy term. The company demonstrated that the insured's driver's license was suspended during the current coverage period. Accordingly, the cancellation action is permitted.
