

*Merritt G. Warren v. Permanent General Assurance Corp.*

The named insured requested a hearing to contest the nonrenewal of his automobile policy for two accidents. The company established the circumstances of the accidents and resulting damages.

**Held:** For the company. 24-A M.R.S. §2916-A permits the nonrenewal of an automobile policy when the named insured is involved in two or more “reportable accidents” within the 36-month period preceding the renewal date. The company demonstrated that the accidents qualified for nonrenewal and that statutory notice requirements were met.
