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# Maine Revenue Services ("MRS") Announces 2021 Tax Filing Season

MRS expects to begin accepting and processing Maine income tax returns filed electronically using <u>Modernized e-File ("MeF")</u> Friday, February 12, 2021. Note that this is also the same date on which the Internal Revenue Service has announced the federal tax filing season will begin.

Effective immediately, taxpayers may file Maine income tax returns on paper.

Effective January 25, 2021, taxpayers may also file Maine income tax returns electronically using Maine I-file.

For calendar-year filers, the deadline for filing the 2020 Maine individual income tax return is Thursday, April 15, 2021.

#### **Availability of Forms**

Most Maine income tax forms for tax year 2020 have been posted to the MRS website at <a href="www.maine.gov/revenue/tax-return-forms">www.maine.gov/revenue/tax-return-forms</a>. All downloadable forms posted on the MRS website are suitable for printing and filing with MRS.

#### **Guidance Materials**

The Income/Estate Tax Division is updating instructions for taxpayers and tax professionals, including guidance documents and frequently asked questions relative to the various tax types on the MRS website.
