Darling's filed a complaint, Board Docket No. 14-01, against Chrysler Group LLC on April 30, 2014, and filed an amended complaint against Chrysler Group on May 5, 2014. Chrysler Group filed a Notice of Removal to the United States District Court on May 19, 2014; on October 30, 2014, the US District Court Granted a Motion filed by Darling's and Remanded this matter to the Board. Following discovery, the Board DENIED FCA's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings, and GRANTED Darling's Motion in part. Board Chairman McCurry held a conference of counsel in the Matter of Darling's v. FCA US, LLC, Docket No. 14-01 on October 13, 2015, at the Bureau of Motor Vehicles Building in Augusta. Attorneys Judy Metcalf and Noreen Patient attended for Darling's; Dan Rosenthal, Esq. was present and attorneys Bob Coltice and Rob Smith attended over the phone to represent FCA US, LLC.

The Board GRANTED Darling's Motion for Entry of Final Order, and ENTERED the parties' Stipulation of Dismissal and FINAL ORDER on November 20, 2015.
