Re: Vanity Plate Application (MV-45) Revision

The Vanity Plate Application (MV-45) is a two-sided, perforated form which is currently produced by an outside vendor. The bureau will be transitioning to an 8 ½ x 11 inch form which will be generated by the BMV Stockroom. The new form will not be available from the BMV Stockroom until the two-sided, perforated forms have been depleted.

Vanity plate information and instructions are no longer included on the Vanity Plate Application (MV-45). Instead, a separate form has been created; Vanity Plate Information and Instructions form (MV-45A). The MV-45A will be available from the BMV Stockroom, once the new vanity plate application is available.

Attached, is a copy of the revised Vanity Plate Application (MV-45) and the Vanity Plate Information and Instructions form (MV-45A).

NOTE: Municipalities may provide the MV-45 and MV-45A to their customers for processing at a BMV branch office. Municipalities cannot process vanity plate applications.
