OUR MISSION

Build a unified program which embraces and reassures Survivors that they are continually linked to the Army Family for as long as they desire.

BENEFITS COORDINATORS

Benefits Coordinators provide expertise on Local, State and Federal benefits. They work closely with Casualty Assistance Officers, providing the Surviving Family with assistance in understanding and applying for their entitlements.



FINANCIAL COUNSELORS

Financial Counselors provide assistance to Surviving Families through investment and estate planning education. Financial counselors work closely with Benefits Coordinators, and other agencies to address the needs of Surviving Families.

SUPPORT COORDINATORS

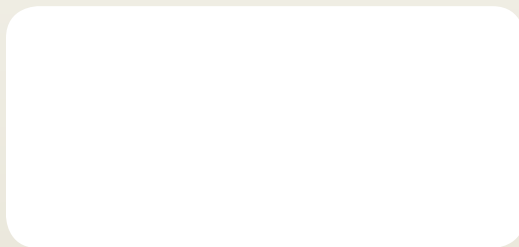
Support Coordinators function as the long term support personnel for Survivors. Support Coordinators facilitate support groups, provide life skills education, and connect Survivors with counseling resources.
