PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION Your Rights & Responsibilities



Pesticides are used every day in Maine for control of insects, weeds, and other pests, to protect our food supply, ourselves, and our homes and gardens.

- If you want to know in advance what pesticides are used and when, **you have the right to know, but it's your responsibility to ask first.**
- Everyone has the right to use pesticides, **but with that right comes the responsibility to abide by the law and notify people who ask.**
